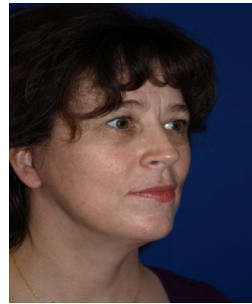
Enter center stage the Rapid Recovery Lift—a procedure performed by Dr. Kelly

Hair Today and Gone Tomorrow

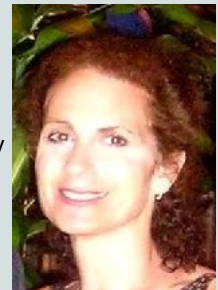

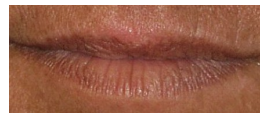

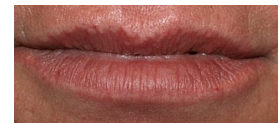
LUSCIOUS LIPS

Ask The Expert



Q: Doctor Kelly – can you tell me the difference between BOTOX and Evolence?

Marie – 43 Plainview, New York

A: Sure—this is a very common question Marie – BOTOX is a muscle softening agent – it creates a smoothing of wrinkles in the upper face (where BOTOX is used) through relaxing the muscles contraction ability. The injectible takes about 5-7 days to set up and the result is a smoother and less tense looking area of injection. The result last for about 3 months. The BOTOX is used in the crows feet area, the frown line area and the forehead. Evolence on the

other hand is a filler – it "fills" lines and wrinkles and is used for the parenthesis around the mouth. A variant of Evolence can be used in the lips to plump and fill fine lines and wrinkles here. The result is immediate and lasts for about 6-8 months. Both are easily tolerated, and you the patient get to direct this type of treatment.
